The Supervisors reviewed the contents of Township Engineer, Michael Weeks letter setting forth four conditions upon which he would then recommend the release. Three of the four items were addressed, and the fourth item cannot be addressed until the holding tank is installed. Mrs. Rose also reminded the Supervisors there are outstanding engineering fees to be reimbursed to the township. She also advised Mr. Shahar was in to pay those fees but Mrs. Stuccio has those figures and she was not at the township the day he was in. Accordingly, on a motion by Mr. Coutts, seconded by Mr. Ehrhardt and unanimously carried Mrs. Rose was authorized to send a letter to The Dime Bank authorizing the release of the guaranty subject to inspection of the holding tank once installed and all outstanding engineering fees being reimbursed to Palmyra Township.
